



Assistant Logger's Job Description

Position Overview

The Assistant Logger is responsible for helping the Logger fall, trim, and work up trees, and transport logs to the sawmill. The Assistant will get on-the-job training with the possibility of advancing to the position of Logger.

- This is a part-time, sub-contract position
- The Assistant Logger will be paid a daily wage
- The length of the day will be around 6± hours of work
- Assistant Logger must sign a liability waiver

Duties

- Assist the Logger falling and working up trees
- Cutting downed trees, including limbing, blocking for sawmill and firewood
- Shred branches (if applicable)
- Stacking branches into brush piles (if no wood chipper is available)
- Transport logs to log storage area
- Transport firewood to firewood storage area
- Stack firewood as needed
- Maintain all equipment, i.e. chainsaws, wood chipper, trailers, etc
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements

- Must be able to lift and move 75 lbs
- Must have experience driving a tractor
- Must have experience using a chainsaw

Characteristics

- Honest, reliable, eye for detail, embrace the concept of continual improvement
